
## **AKISAN Scholarship Announcement 2009 / 2010**

### **AWARD CRITERIA /INSTRUCTIONS**

- Awardees' tertiary institution of learning will furnish the Association (AKISAN) annual transcripts for verification of attendance and grade point average (GPA).
